

Hunt For Donley

Doctor Terry Houck had been one of the leading Stavrosian Doctors to the Stavrosian communities. His unique insight of Stavrosian physiology made him the best choice to care for many of the families. Once located in New York, he moved to Oregon to practice medicine for known families in the tri-state area. He ran a family practice for more than thirty years. Doctor Houck was well respected by all he served.

The Doctor was also known for " The Calling". That skill developed all through his life. His ability to communicate at great distances made it possible to diagnose and treat patients anywhere they were once they had made contact.

The two S.G.L. men spent almost two weeks working on this case. Doctor Houck was worried that if any information was sold it could be dangerous for the Stavrosian families. This whole thing could be made into a big deal, something the families did not want to happen.

A break came when one of the unscrupulous men said his name to an interested buyer. The name was Carl Donley living in Idaho. The two S.G.L. men went to Idaho to track down Donley. They arrived in Idaho Falls on Monday, November 18th 2019. They had a potential address in Twin Falls. When they reached town, the men stayed at a hotel in Eden to set up for another session of the Calling.

On Wednesday the 20th, they got the hit they were waiting for. It took nine hours of monitoring and meditation to finally pick up on Donley. The team learned that Donley was planning to sell his services to a company with government contracts. It was not important what contracts they had. It was now Mission One to stop Donley at once; allowing himself to be used would most likely start a government search for others with the skill. Much like the Russian disaster, the S.G.L. could not let that happen. The team went to Donley's residence in Twin Falls, Tuesday 26th of November 2019. He lived off Shoup Avenue in an old loft apartment.

When Donley came to the door and saw the two men, he knew why they were there. Paul Stevenson made eye contact that set Donley on a blind-flight run. They gave chase, Paul wanted to have a heart-to-heart talk with Donley in hopes he would reconsider this crime against the Stavrosian community. Donley was in very good shape. He outran the two men and Paul and Alex went back to their rental car. They drove around the area and Paul did see Donley briefly on Fillmore and then lost him around Addison Ave. Paul looked for Donley until December 7th. A twelve-day manhunt found nothing on Donley.

Once back at the hotel, they began another session of the Calling. Alex Hofstetter started to pick out some chatter on Donley. He had made it to the airport. He was now in New York. Donley felt safer there, it is a place that was so full of thought patterns it would be very difficult to pinpoint his location. Paul arrived in New York and went to the library to report in and ask for more help. He got that help on December 27th, 2019, with six more S.G.L. to help locate Donley.

The team set up a triangle from White Plains to Plainview and down to Long Beach. The area was scanned for a one-week search. Then on January 3, 2020 Paul's team picked up Donley's location. He was hiding in Levittown near Northside elementary school. The team was able to track him to a Jerusalem Avenue field in their parking lot. As Paul approached Donley's car, he jumped out taking off on foot. Paul's team was able to take Donley down on Fisher Lane. Hofstetter took Donley to the New York office for holding until dispositioned

This report end's here, we have not heard what has happened to Donley. Paul received a few days of rest before being reassigned.
