

Nick Pope, Brian Higley and Huber Von Hoffman

Brian Higley and Huber Von Hoffman were two S.G.L. security team members. Brian Higley of the London office was assigned to investigate what knowledge the British Government's Ministry of Defense, Nick Pope, had on Alien presence in England. The German office of the S.G.L. assigned Huber Von Hoffman to keep an ongoing surveillance of Pope's research as well as any important findings. The S.G.L. had become aware of Pope's work. This drew their concern about Pope. He had been looking into so many reports. The Stavrosian community was now taking notice of Nick's progress. The fear that he may uncover the Stavrosian people living in England could jeopardize their existence.

Brian and Huber were given the roles of monitoring and reporting Nick's activities. The S.G.L. began their surveillance in 1991 until 2010. When Pope moved to America to continue his investigating, Brian and Huber followed. It was abundantly clear that Nick did not share the same view of the British Government. He knew the British were going to cover up his findings. By coming to the United States, he hoped he could find allies. Nick would talk to anyone that were willing to listen to him with an open mind.

Huber Von Hoffman was skilled in leaking misinformation to keep eyes off the Stavrosian people. Huber had once made an acquaintance with Nick. He presented himself as a UFO investigator to engage Pope in casual conversation. Huber spent from 2013 to 2020 working behind the scenes sending Nick Pope misinformation in several ways. Huber used Stavrosians within the British Government to mislead Pope. He had members of the S.G.L with political influence in America try to discredit Pope's work. The S.G.L. also had a simple campaign to mock the notion of an Alien presence.

In 2020 it has come to the attention of the S.G.L. at the last meeting in Chicago that perhaps this intense effort has been a miscalculation. The years trying to protect Stavrosians may have been better served in trying to guide Nick to the truth. With the understanding that Nick Pope could have been a friend of Stavros as a believer. The decision to explore this avenue has not yet been made.

Brian Higley returned to England in January 2021. He had, in America contracted Covid - 19. Brian was 98 years old.

Due to complications, he died February 4th, 2021. Huber Von Hoffman has been recalled to the German office for reassignment until a decision can be made. Nick Pope continues his work no longer impeded by Stavrosian fear of being exposed.

It is with a complicated regret that Nick was kept out of knowing the truth. Perhaps in the future a better use of time and talent will help the Stavrosian people communicate more freely with possible allies. In the event a decision is reached to approach Nick Pope, I truly hope it can be done in a safe mature and openminded exchange of good will between Nick and the Stavrosian hybrid community.
