## The Belarus Triangular

On the night of October 2, 2022, an unknown object over Belarus was spotted on Russian radar. The incident was radioed to the Russian air command. The report was first sent over an unsecured radio frequency. It was then picked up by Lithuania Air Reserves. Their report was put out on open air radio. The S.G.L., while monitoring radio traffic, found the report and then sent it on to the Library for review to check authenticity by staff. They sent it in for a reissue request. It was signed by G, Wheaton before being released for limited public / Ufology organizations usage.

The following is taken from the original broadcast report.

On October 2, 2022, Sergeant Luryi of the Belarus Air Service was monitoring his radar post along with his Russian advisor. At about 11:00 he noticed a blip on the screen he was stationed at. His advisor called in the anomaly to his supervisors. He was told to watch and track the object's flight.

As it passed over the city of Minsk, it was observed by locals as a triangular shaped craft dark in color. With five or six lights visible from the ground. It was noted that it looked like there were two of these craft flying together. Their tracking speed was lumbarishly slow, steadily moving southeast. As the two passed over Borisov city the Russians scrambled two jet fighters. The triangular craft continued southeast passing over the town of Rechitsa. Here is where the two jets caught up with them.

At first the Russian pilots just followed and observed. A nervous Russian Colonel Fenor ordered them to fire on the two craft. Both triangular craft were hit by rockets from the jets. The pilots reported that there was no effect. The crafts flew out across Ukraine air space. The jets followed until they flew over the Ukrainian city Korosten. Ground fire from Ukrainian ground to air mobile defense batteries started to fire at the jets.

In all the military melee the two craft kept traveling south until they were lost off radar. The official Russian response was that they were in pursuit of what they believed were American spy planes.

Friendly (Stavrosian) sources from within the pentagon have unofficially denied any activity over Belarus on that date. Stavrosians working within the system have confirmed that the crafts were not American spy planes. There are other reports from that night, 10/2/2022, from inside Ukrainian about the same or similar craft. The Ukrainian skies are areas of interest to everyone.
