

Ukraine Reports

Copy of report to S.G.L..
Rerouted to Ufology groups / friends.

On April 11, 2022, this report was sent in by an Air traffic controller from an airfield in Moldova. Ivan Pavlovich has worked as a Traffic controller for the past ten years. He initially received his training in America when he served as a Moldavian Air Reservist. He took the position at the airfield in 2010. He was promoted in 2012 to Lead Controller.

Most of his career was uneventful. Once the Russian invasion of the Ukraine began, the skies over Moldavia became active. There was the occasional Russian jet, sometimes a Polish military cargo aircraft passed overhead. Once-in-a-while an American plane flew over. Although this presented itself as only a curiosity, Ivan did not ponder on this except to say he understood this as part of the war in Ukraine.

On the April 2, 2022 night shift, Ivan watched the radar showed something coming in fast. A closer look showed the radar blips had stopped. With each pass of the radar beam the blips just stopped in place. Ivan called people in the area to see if anything was out there or if anyone saw it or have a radar hit of their own. Ground personnel reported three objects brightly shining like stars in the sky.

He had not received any other calls from ground or air personnel. These objects stayed in place for another forty-five minutes. The three objects began to descend until it appeared they had touched down. A truck was sent. The ground vehicle drove as close as they dared to the craft. The truck was manned by four young reservists. Two of the men exited the truck to investigate. The others stayed with the truck then waited for about two hours before they returned. When they arrived back something appeared wrong.

The two men were now wearing each other's clothes. Both men were confused, unaware of the clothing switch. They were taken to the airfield. Here Ivan was able to talk to them, they were still somewhat disoriented. One of the men complained about a burning sensation on his arm. When Ivan checked the man's arm, he could see that a portion of skin had been removed. The other man said his feet hurt so Ivan asked to see the man's feet. Skin from his ankles and from the bottom of both feet had been removed. The cuts were very precise so as not to cause much bleeding.

When Ivan asked the men what had happened, they could not say with any positive determination what they had just gone through. Ivan reported what he had seen and found with the reservists. His report went to Maldivian Air Reserves Security. Here the report was picked up by a radio station. It was broadcasted locally. At that time, it was monitored by S.G.L. field researchers.

Although not a Stavrosian story, it was sent to the S.G.L.. G. Wheaton believed it to be worthy of a look. She sent a field researcher to investigate and collaborate on the report and advised her team to route the report to the usual groups. That has helped the S.G.L.. The list of Ufology research groups and friends of Stavros included but not restricted to the Roundtown "RUFOS" group.
